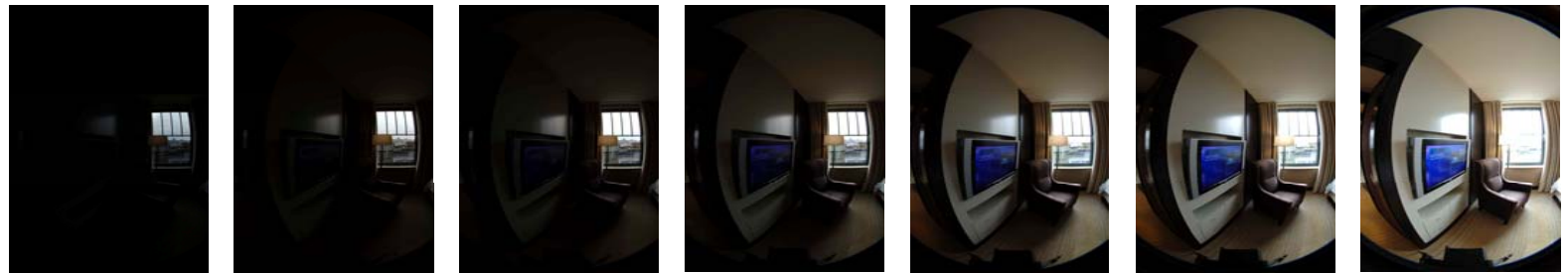


Double Exposure Tour Option - 360WorldGuide

DX is a double exposure production with the camera set to capture a variety of exposures to cover the inside as well as the outside view of a room. This is also very useful when design details in a room have different exposures, such as lamps and chandeliers that normally will be very bright and hence overexposed. These images will later be digitally merged into one 360-image (tour). The standard tour will normally have the windows overexposed and this will make the windows look white, hence blocking the view. As the DX require very much post production time at our design studio we only recommend the DX option when this extra service is making a definite difference. The charge is equivalent of 2 tours for each DX.



These images are an example of how it works. The smaller images with different exposure is merged together to look like the larger picture. A 360-image is shot with an 8 mm fisheye lens is produced in 4 sections giving a full 360 degree view. The distortion in the images is due to the special lens and this will disappear when stitched together.
